
EEF RESIDENTIAL APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAMME

EEF's Engineering Apprentice Programme offers the highest quality training, with flexible delivery options, at our Technical Training Campus based in the heart of Birmingham. EEF's residential option, opens the door for companies around the country to send their apprentices to train at our state of the art facilities.

Established over the last four years, the residential programme allows companies access to full time off the job training delivered in a high tech simulated manufacturing environment. The working environment ensures the apprentices are work ready and have a professional mind-set that translates seamlessly into the workplace.

PROGRAMME BENEFITS

- All apprentices, from around the country, have the same experience in their first year training, which enables the company to standardise it's apprenticeship programme across the country.
- The Residential Model improves networking between company sites. Feedback from our current clients demonstrates that apprentices have continued to network, share problems and regularly visit other sites, on their own initiative.
- Independent living, in a safe environment, has led to an increased maturity among apprentices and an increased mobility to the workforce.

MONITORING

As with all of our programmes, EEF will provide on-going Management Information with regard to timekeeping and attendance, and progress throughout the first year of the programme. EEF will assign a Student Liaison Officer to each client, who will provide regular updates on progress of all learners.

SAFEGUARDING

All apprenticeships are open to 16 year olds and upwards and our residential programme is no different. Apprentices are required to sign in and out of the hotel, to allow us to monitor the movements of all apprentices. The hotel and EEF management are at the end of a 24/7 emergency line should any issues occur.

EEF work in close partnership with our chosen hotel to ensure Safeguarding procedures are in place at all times and risk assessments are carried out on a regular basis.

Learner Voice groups are set up at the beginning of each year, to allow the opportunity to feedback on the performance of the hotel and if any improvements can be made.



RESIDENTIAL FACILITIES

The service includes:

- Full breakfast & 3 course evening meal
- Designated Area within the restaurant, with rotating menu
- Single and Double rooms with en-suite and typical TV, Wi-Fi etc.
- Leisure facilities – pool, gym, exercise classes, apprentice break out room

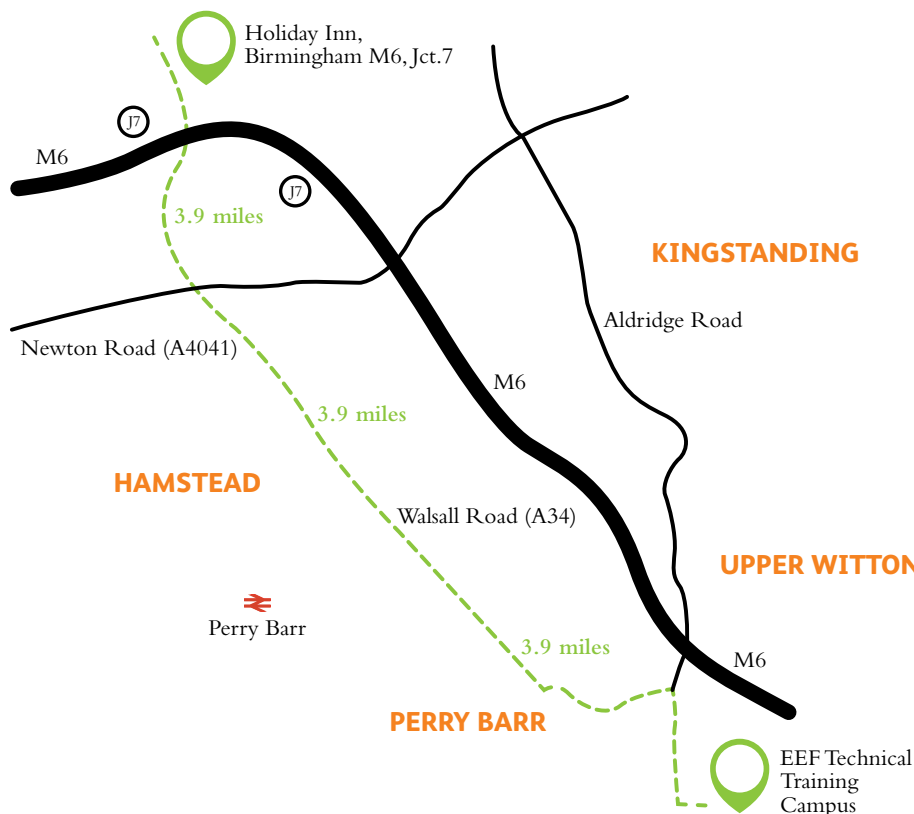
LOGISTICS

Apprentices tend to arrive to the hotel on a Sunday night ready for a 8am start on Monday morning. The residential stay lasts **five nights** until Friday morning, where apprentices complete an 8am-12.30pm morning and travel back home for the weekend.

EEF provides a shuttle bus from the hotel the training centre each day.

DURATION & PROVISIONAL COSTS

Each apprenticeship pathway is different and our delivery team will try to estimate the number of weeks the training will take in the first and second year, to allow you to estimate the total cost. Once the timetable is confirmed the hotel room/s are booked on your behalf, by EEF staff, and actual costs are invoiced.
